The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, all members of the Board being present.

The Board authorized Clerk of the Court Mary Ellen Simmons to hire extra help for her office in refiling the cases, in accordance with the adopted scale of pay, seventy five (75) cents per hour for experienced help.

Welfare Director Mildred Watson appeared before the Board to discuss Welfare matters.

The Board authorized an increase in salary for Mrs. Joe Bailey, stenographer to County Attorney Robert B. Oyler, said increase to be \$10.00 per month, making a total of \$130.00 per month, effective as of March 1, 1950.

Floyd Perdue of the Road & Bridge Department is to be advanced \$5.00 per month, making a total of \$190.00 per month, effective as of March 1, 1950.

The Board adjourned to view and act as a Board of Appraisers the Road allowed by the Board in the petition of Mrs. Laura Dennis and Others, filed October 3, 1949, located in Section 23, Township 13S, Range 20E; and, The Road allowed by the Board in the petition of Benjamin Neis and Others, filed October 10, 1949, located in Section 34, Township 12S, Range 21E.
