

## COMMISSIONER'S RECORD O

## AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 13th day of March, 1950, by and between The Board of Trustees of The Church of the Brethren of Lone Star, Douglas County, Kansas, hereinafter referred to as party of the first part, and The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, hereinafter referred to as party of the second part;

WITNESSETH: In mutual consideration of the covenants herein contained it is by the parties hereto agreed;

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THAT, WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has on this date ordered that a certain road as hereinafter described be laid out, as provided by law, which road is for the public good and convenience; and

WHEREAS, the party of the first part does by these presents remise, release and quit claim unto the said Douglas County, Kansas, the land to be used for a road, as hereinafter described, for the sum and consideration of One DOLLAR (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration. The parties hereto agree that the said Board of County Commissioners will construct a cattle crossing under said road and will keep the same in good repair; and it is further agreed that a well on the property of the party of the first part will not be damaged or injured.

It is further agreed that the land conveyed, released and quit claimed by the party of the first part to the party of the second part for the purpose of laying out a road is as follows:

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Beginning at a point in Road #20 approximately 466 ft. East of the center of Section Eleven (11), Township Fourteen (14), Range Eighteen (18); thence in a Southwesterly direction for approximately 900 ft. to a point in the present Road #20, in Douglas County, Kansas;

Said roadway to be a width of 66 ft. and said land being  $1\frac{1}{2}$  acres, more or less.

WE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS. Acting under the Laws of 1923, Chapter 68, Article 114, which reads as follows, "PROCEEDINGS FOR CHANGES IN ROADS. When it is found necessary to relocate a road or highway for the purpose of eliminating sharp turns or other dangerous places, or for the proper construction of a highway, or for the extension of a bridge or culvert, the board of county commissioners shall by order of said board, relocate a public road and may vacate an existing road. All land required for the laying out, widening or altering of a road shall be acquired by the board of county commissioners by purchase or by donation."
