Gentlemen:

We propose to furnish all the labor, materials and equipment necessary for a completed application of a 20 year bonded tar and gravel roof on the above mentioned building.

This roof will contain not less than the following quantities of materials per 100 square foot of roof area:

Manufacturers specifications for the application of the above materials will be adhered to. Base flashing and cap flashing to raglet blocks will be installed and is a part of this proposal.

Twenty-eight gauge G. I. gravel stops will be installed and properly flashed in place.

Upon completion of the above work, the manufacturers surity bond for 20 years will be issued on the above roof.

All work will be performed by fully insured skilled workmen complete for the sum of one thousand sixty-three dollars and eighty-eight cents. (\$1,063.88)

We hope this proposal meets with your approval and that you will return the original copy to this office so that we can take the necessary steps to perform the above proposal.
