The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, all members of the Board being present.

The Board discussed welfare matters with the director, Mrs. Watson.

Bids were opened for trucks. Morgan-Mack submitted bids for two 1½ Ton dump trucks and one ½ Ton panel truck. Two dump trucks \$4584.00, one panel truck at \$1585.60, total \$6169.60; less trade-in on panel, \$285.60, and less a discount of \$250.00 if all three are taken, making a total of \$5634.00.

The Sanders Motor Co., one 1950 Studebaker \$2352.55, standard equipment, and \$60.00 added for 825 X 20-10 ply rear dual tires.

The Winter Chevrolet, two 1950 2 Ton trucks at \$2681.77, less \$332.45 discount, net \$2349.32 each. One panel truck at \$1579.35, less trade-in \$330.35, or net of \$1249.00.

The Hunsinger Motor Co., two 1½ Ton dump trucks at \$2261.10 each, or a total of \$4522.20. No bid made on panel truck.

On motion by Mr. Banning, seconded by Mr. Ogden, the Board accepted the low bid of Morgan-Mack on the trucks, and on vote called, motion carried.

The Board signed the purchase order for one 255A Trench Hoe for Harnischfeger shovel at \$3125.00, f.o.b. factory to Kansas City, Kansas.
