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WHEREAS, the Board does find that the said Karl Kappelman is in all ways qualified under the law to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on the premises, and

WHEREAS, the Board further finds that due and legal notice has been given to the Wakarusa Township Board and that ten days have expired from the giving of said notice to the Township Board,

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Chapter 68, Section 141 G, of the Laws of Kansas, 1947, provides that the "governing body of any municipality by resolution is authorized and empowered to transfer, annually, from the road, bridge, or street fund of such municipality not to exceed twenty-five percent of the amount of money credited to any such fund, and subject to legal expenditure in such year, to a special road, bridge or street building machinery and equipment fund"; and

WHEREAS, Douglas County has a cash balance of \$16,899.92 and an unexpended budget balance of \$12,675.45 in its road fund as of the end of the fiscal year 1950; and,

WHEREAS, Douglas County operated under a budget appropriation of \$115,000.00 in its Road Fund for the year 1950, 25% of which would total \$28,750.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County does hereby authorize its treasurer to transfer \$12,500.00 from its Road Fund to the special Road Equipment and Machinery Fund, which sum does not exceed 25% of the amount of money which could have been spent as limited by law for the year 1950.
