The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, all members of the Board being present.

The following resolution was passed by the Board granting Agnes Belcher the right to a beer license for the Blue Bird:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 27th day of December, 1950, the same being a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, of Douglas County, the application of Agnes Belcher, for a beer license came on for consideration of said Board, and

WHEREAS, the Board does find that the said Agnes Belcher is in all ways qualified under the law to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on the premises, and

WHEREAS, the Board further finds that due and legal notice has been given to the Grant Township Board and that ten days have expired from the giving of said notice, and that no written objection has been filed by the Grant Township Board, protesting the granting of a beer license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the applicant, Agnes Belcher be granted a license to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on premises at the place so described in application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that T. R. Gerhart, County Clerk of Douglas County be and he is hereby directed to issue said license.
