January 10, 1951

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, all members of the Board being present.

Additional bills for equipment and supplies were approved and allowed by the Board as per the Allowance Record.

The following resolution was passed by the Board in regard to fees charged by the County Surveyor:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 10th day of January, 1951, the same being a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, the price scale for work by the County Surveyor came on for consideration of the Board, and

WHEREAS, the cost of material and equipment has increased to such an extent the present price scale does not cover the present cost,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the County Surveyor be granted the right to increase the price scale as follows:

Four corners or less	\$17.50
Surveys and building location	20.00
Extra pins, per pin (no change)	1.50
Photostats (no change)	1.00
Plats and Prints	5.00
Prints (no change)	.25 and up
County Surveys	4.00

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Surveyor be and he is hereby directed to charge the above price effective as of February 1, 1951, for surveying.
