RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE FOLLOWING COUNTY OFFICIALS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, TO DEPOSIT ALL MONIES RECEIVED BY THEM IN THEIR OFFICIAL CAPACITIES IN THE BANKS AS DESIGNATED AS FOLLOWS:
