The following resolution was passed by the Board allowing the Country Club to sell beer:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of January, 1951, the same being a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, of Douglas County, the application of the Lawrence Country Club, with Pat Conn, Manager, came on for consideration of said Board, and

WHEREAS, the Board does find that the said Lawrence Country Club is in all ways qualified under the law to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on the premises, and

WHEREAS, the Board further finds that due and legal notice has been given to the Wakarusa Township Board and that ten days have expired from the giving of said notice, and that no written objections has been filed by the Wakarusa Township Board, protesting the granting of a beer license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the applicant, The Lawrence Country Club, with Pat Conn, Manager, be granted a license to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on premises at the place so described in application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT T. R. Gerhart, County Clerk of Douglas County be and he is hereby directed to issue said license.

The Road Petition of Clayton Stone and Others was received by the Board and filed in the Office of the County Clerk, asking for a road located in:

The SouthEast corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 14, Range 19; thence West along section line for a distance of 66 rods to South East corner of the 71 acre tract of land owned by Clayton L. Stone and Virginia I. Stone, husband and wife, and terminating at this point.

The Eudora Township Board appeared before the Board: Ralph Votaw, Trustee; Eugene McCabria, Clerk; Otto Rosenau, Treasurer.

The Board of County Commissioners authorized the Eudora Township Board to maintain the County Road between the Kansas River Bridge and the Wakarusa River Bridge North of Eudora, and agrees to pay the Eudora Township Board one hundred dollars (100.00) a year, effective as of January 20, 1951, and letter to that effect sent the Eudora Township Board, copy of said letter being on file in County Clerks Office.

The Board also discussed the straightening of the road between Sections 23 and 24 in Township 13, Range 20, with the Eudora Township Board. No action was taken as of this date.

The Board discussed welfare matters with the director, Mrs. Watson.

The Board discussed road and bridge matters with county engineer J.I. Rice.

The Board adjourned to meet Monday, January 22, 1951.
