The petition asked for a road beginning at the NorthEast corner of Section 19, Township 12 South, Range 18 East; thence North about one-fourth mile to intersect U. S. Highway No. 40.

The Board will meet this afternoon at 2:00 o'clock P.M. to view the road asked for by Clayton Stone and Others in the road petition filed January 18, 1951, described as: Beg. at SouthEast corner of SouthEast quarter of Section 9, Township 14, Range 19; thence West along Section line for a distance of sixty-six rods to South East corner of the seventy-one (71) acre tract of land owned by Clayton L. Stone and Virginia I. Stone, husband and wife, and terminating at this point.

Leslie Demeritt, Bindweed Supervisor, appeared before the Board with his application for Bindweed Supervisor for 1951. Said application was approved by the Board, and notarized by County Clerk T. R. Gerhart. The original and copies of the application are to be sent to Topeka for approval of the State, at same rate of pay.
