RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, unanimously finds that it is to the best interest of Douglas County, Kansas to sell and dispose of, as provided by Sec. 19-211 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, the following described personal property, to-wit:

TD9 International Crawler Type Tractor, 30 horsepower, Serial #TDCD20832T7CC, with attached Bucyrus Eri H1 Loader 3/4 Yard Bucket, Serial #41639

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, finds that the value of the above described personal property is approximately \$2,000.00 dollars.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session, assembled this 14th day of February, 1951, that the above described personal property be sold to the highest bidder, cash in hand, as provided by Sec. 19-211 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, and that publication notice for at least 20 days, of said proposed sale, be given in some newspaper, printed in the English language and generally circulated in Douglas County Kansas, and that the said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas reserve the right to reject any or all bids and as a further condition of said sale require that a certified check in the amount of ten per cent of the bids submitted shall accompany said bid.
