February 17, 1951

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, all members of the Board being present.

The Board discussed road and bridge matters with the county engineer J. I. Rice.

The Board discussed welfare matters with the director, Mrs. Watson.

Motion by Mr. Ousdahl, second by Mr. Banning, the petition to establish a cemetery district known as the Twin Mound Cemetery District be granted, and on vote being called, the motion carried.

The following resolution was passed by the Board in accordance with the provisions of Section 17-1330 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, for the establishment of a cemetery district known as the Twin Mound Cemetery District, on file in County Clerks office:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a Petition setting forth and requesting a proposed cemetery district, hereinafter described, and signed by not less than fifty-one per cent of the qualified electors of said proposed district, which has been determined by an enumeration taken and verified for this purpose by, J. T. Petefish, a qualified elector of said proposed district, has been presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas in which lies all of the territory comprising said district, and

WHEREAS, the said Board of County Commissioners at its next regular meeting held on this 17th day of February, 1951, did examine said Petition and find that said Petition is regular and in due form with the provisions of Section 17-1330 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas in regular meeting held this 17th day of February, 1951, a quorum of said Board being present, that they shall and do hereby enter an order establishing the following described cemetery district, said district to be designated as the Twin Mound Cemetery District:

Commence at the Northwest corner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 23, Twp. 13, Range 17, thence East on half section line through Sections 23, 23, in Township 13, Range 17, thence continue East on half section line through Sections 19 and 20 to the Northeast corner of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20, Township 13, Range 18, thence South on half Section line through Sections 20, 29 and 32, in Township 13, Range 18, thence continue South on half section line to South line of Section 5, thence West on South line said Section 5 to Southwest corner of Section 5, thence South on Section line to the Southwest corner of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, thence West on half Section line through Section 7 to the intersection of a road running in a northwesterly direction, thence following said road in a northwesterly direction to the intersection of said road with the West line of E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7, thence South on said line to the South line of said Section 7, thence West on said South line to the West line of Section 7 all in Township 14, Range 18, thence South on the East line of Section 13, Township 14, Range 17, to the Southeast corner of said Section 13, thence West along South line of Sections 13 and 14, in Township 14, Range 17, to the West line of Sections 14, 11 and 2, in Township 14, Range 17, thence continue North on the West line of Sections 35, 26 and 23, in Township 13, Range 17, to the place of beginning, all in Douglas County, Kansas.
