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## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, unanimously finds that the following described real estate is no longer needed for the use of said County and finds that it is to the best interests of Douglas County, Kansas to sell, as provided by Section 19-211 of the General Statutes of Kansas for 1949, said following described real estate being owned by and in possession of said County, and specifically described as follows:

Lots No. 26, 28, and 30 on Connecticut Street, in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas further finds the value of the above described real estate is more than \$5,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session assembled this 17th day of February, 1951, that the proposition of selling the above described real property be submitted to a vote of the electors of Douglas County, Kansas, at a special election called for the purpose of voting upon the question of selling the above described property in Douglas County, Kansas, said special election to be held on April 3, 1951 as provided by law and that notice of said special election be given as provided by law.

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The following resolution was passed by the Board in accordance with the Petition filed by the Executive Board of The Douglas County 4-H and Community Activity Committee asking for the adoption of a resolution pursuant to the provisions of Section 19-1561 of the General Supplements of 1947, as amended, submitting to the vote of the people at a Special Election to be held in connection with the City Election the request for a 4-H Fairgrounds and Building, Notice of Publication being sent to all three official county papers, to be published once, said resolution being on file in Office of County Clerk:

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have met at a regular session on this 17th day of February, 1951, the following commissioners being present: Chairman, Ray C. Ogden; Commissioner, Elmer W. Ousdahl; and Commissioner, Charles E. Banning.

WHEREAS, a petition is presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, by the Executive Board of the Douglas County 4-H and Community Activity Committee, requesting said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, to adopt a resolution pursuant to the provisions of Section 19-1561 of the General Statutes of Kansas for 1949, submitting to the qualified electors of Douglas County, Kansas, at a special election for said purpose, as provided by law, the following proposition:

Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas, be authorized to make an annual levy of not to exceed one mill upon all tangible property of Douglas County, Kansas, for the purpose of creating and providing a building fund to be used for the acquiring of a site for, the erecting and equipping of, and the furnishing of a building or buildings to be used for 4-H Club purposes, livestock shows, and other agricultural or civic activities; said levy to be made annually for a period of not to exceed two years and to be in addition to all other levies authorized or limited by law?

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, unanimously finds that the above described petition should be granted and that the proposition, hereinbefore stated, should be submitted to the qualified electors of Douglas County, Kansas, at a special election to be held on Tuesday, April 3, 1951.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in a regular session assembled this 17th day of February, 1951 that the above stated proposition be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of Douglas County, Kansas, at a special election called for the purpose of voting upon said proposition. Said special election to be held on April 3, 1951, and that notice of said special election be given all as provided by law.
