The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular session, according to law, to canvass the votes cast in the Special Election held on April 3, 1951, Elmer W. Ousdahl and Charles E. Banning being present.

On motion by Mr. Banning, the following corrections be made in the Certificates of the Special Election of April 3, 1951:

Reduce from 92 to 87 votes in favor of Proposition 2 in Eudora Twp.;
Reduce from 340 to 335 the votes against Prop. 2 in 1st Ward, Lawrence;
Reduce from 459 to 456 the votes against Prop. 2 in 3rd Ward, Lawrence;
Reduce from 438 to 437 votes in favor of Prop. 2 in 4th Ward, Lawrence.

It is further moved that the summary of votes cast as recorded on page 240 of the Abstract of Votes Cast be approved and signed by the Board of County Commissioners, second by Mr. Ousdahl.
