RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PLAN FOR EXTENDING THE BENEFITS OF TITLE II OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, IN CONFORMITY WITH THE APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF SUCH ACT, TO THE EMPLOYEES OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO EXECUTE AND THE CLERK TO ATTEST SUCH PLAN FOR SAID DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, AND SUBMIT THE SAME TO THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL SERVICE, THE STATE AGENCY.

WHEREAS, House Bill No. 500, Sessions Laws of Kansas, 1951, authorizes the political subdivisions of the State of Kansas to submit plans to the State Agency to extend the benefits of Title II of the Social Security Act to employees of such political subdivisions, and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, believes that the benefits of said Social Security Act should be extended to the employees of such County, now,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that Douglas County, Kansas, hereby extends the benefits of Title II of the Federal Social Security Act, in conformity with the applicable provisions of such Act, to the employees of said County according to the provisions of House Bill 500, Session Laws of Kansas, 1951, in accordance with and under the terms of the following plan:

The Board discussed welfare matters with the director, Mrs. Watson, and approved the welfare budget for 1951-1952.

On motion by Mr. Ousdahl, second by Mr. Banning, and on vote being taken, motion carried, beginning in 1952, the Board will set up in the 1951-1952 budget a fund to take care of the Social Security payments to be made on the part of the county for the retroactive deductions be made as follows: First quarter deduction

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
