The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, Ray C. Ogden and Elmer W. Ousdahl being present.

On motion of Mr. Ousdahl and second by Mr. Ogden, the payment for the poor and indigent funeral charges of the county be increased from \$100.00 to \$150.00 for each funeral, and undertaker to take care of all other expenses. On vote being taken motion carried.

The Board entered into an agreement with Hugh Means for the purchase of thirty-eight acres described as per agreement for 4-H purposes, said agreement as follows:

AGREEMENT

This contract and agreement made and entered into this 19th day of September, 1951, by and between, Hugh Means, a single man of Lawrence, Kansas, hereinafter referred to as Party of the First Part and the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, hereinafter referred to as Party of the Second Part.

Witnesseth, that the said Party of the First Part hereby agrees to sell and convey to the said Party of the Second Part the following described real estate to wit:

South one-Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and Eight (8) Acres off the North side of the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 5, Township 13, Range 20 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian containing 28 Acres, more or less.

Begin at a point Twenty (20) rods South of the Northwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 5, Township 13, Range 20; thence running East 80 Rods; thence South 20 Rods; thence West 80 Rods; thence North 20 Rods to the place of beginning containing 10 Acres, more or less, all of the above described real estate subject to easement in B-137, P-223 Cities Service Gas Co.

on the following terms and conditions.

The Party of the Second Part agrees to pay the total sum of Nine Thousand Dollars (\$9000.00 to Party of the First Part for said above described real estate; said Nine Thousand Dollars (\$9000.00) to be paid as follows: Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to be held in escrow by the escrow agent of these parties, the First National Bank, Lawrence, Kansas, and the balance of Eighty-Five Hundred Dollars (\$8500.00) to be paid on or about January 15, 1952, at which time said Five Hundred dollars (\$500.00) escrow payment will also be delivered to Party of the First Part.
