The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular session, all members of the Board being present.

The Board discussed road and bridge matters with county engineer J.I. Rice. Commissioners Order No. 638 is approved by the Board.

The Board discussed jail matters with the Sheriff Travis E. Glass.

The Road and Bridge Department is authorized to make repairs at the jail not to exceed \$500.00.

County Superintendent of Public Instruction Emma Berg is authorized to purchase an adding machine.

The Board met with the Jefferson County Board of Commissioners and the Jefferson County Engineer at Topeka to discuss the acquisition of spans of the Brickyard Bridge from the State Highway Department.

The following resolution was passed by the Board authorizing the transfer of Funds from the Road Fund to a special road, bridge, or street building machinery and equipment fund:

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS Chapter 68, Section 141 G, of the Laws of Kansas, 1947, provides that the "governing body of any municipality by resolution is authorized and empowered to transfer, annually, from the road, bridge, or street fund of such municipality not to exceed twenty-five percent of the amount of money credited to any such fund, and subject to legal expenditure in such year, to a special road, bridge or street building machinery and equipment and bridge building fund, and

WHEREAS, Douglas County has a cash balance of \$41,781.35 and an unexpended budget balance of \$38,249.16 in its road fund as of the end of the fiscal year 1951; and,

WHEREAS, Douglas County operated under a budget appropriation of \$175,000.00 in its Road Fund for the year 1951, 25% of which total \$43,750.00; and bridge

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County does hereby authorize its treasurer to transfer \$38,200.00 from its Road Fund to the Special Road, Bridge or Street Building Machinery Fund, which sum does not exceed 25% of the amount of money which could have been spent as limited by law for the year 1951.
