The Board discussed 4-H building construction with County Agent Deal Six.

The following resolution was passed by the Board granting John W. Dobbins the right to sell beer at the place of business described as the "Chuck Wagon":

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 2nd day of January, 1951, the same being a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, of Douglas County, the application of John W. Dobbins, for a beer license came on for consideration of said Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board does find that the said John W. Dobbins is in all ways qualified under the law to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on the premises, and

WHEREAS, the Board further finds that due and legal notice has been given to the Wakarusa Township Board and that ten days have expired from the giving of said notice, and that no written objection has been filed by the Wakarusa Township Board, protesting the granting of a beer license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the applicant, John W. Dobbins be granted a license to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on premises at the place so described in application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT T. R. Gerhart, County Clerk of Douglas County be and he is hereby directed to issue said license.
