The following resolution was passed by the Board granting J. C. Poindexter the right to sell beer at the place of business described as Oak Lodge:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of January, 1952, the same being a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, of Douglas County, the application of J. C. Poindexter, for a beer license came on for consideration of said Boards, and

WHEREAS, the Board does find that the said J. C. Poindexter is in all ways qualified under the law to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on the premises, and

WHEREAS, the Board further finds that due and legal notice has been given to the Willow Springs Township Board and that ten days have expired from the giving of said notice, and that no written objection has been filed by the Willow Springs Township Board, protesting the granting of a beer license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the applicant, J. C. Poindexter be granted a license to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on premises at the place so described in application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT T. R. Gerhart, County Clerk of Douglas County be and he is hereby directed to issue said license.
