The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, all members of the Board being present.

The Board entered into a joint resolution with the City of Lawrence to create a joint Douglas County Defense and Disaster Council. On motion by Banning and seconded by Ousdahl the resolution be adopted, and on vote taken the motion carried unanimously. Said resolution is as follows:

RESOLUTION

Joint Resolution of the City Commission of
Lawrence and The County Commission of Douglas County,
Relating to a Lawrence--Douglas County Defense
And Disaster Council.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the governing body of the City of Lawrence and the County of Douglas to cooperate in the creation of a joint City--County Committee for the purpose of maintaining an adequate civil defense program.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence and the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, agreeing thereto, that a Lawrence--Douglas County Defense and Disaster Council be created as follows:

Each governing body shall select one of its members to serve on said committee and the two members thus appointed shall appoint a citizen of the community as a third member of said committee. This committee shall in turn appoint a director.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds of each Governing Body be kept separate.

Passed by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, this 8th day of April, 1952.
