## EASEMENT

The Northwest Quarter of Section 17, Township 13, Range 20, in Douglas County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, the ditch along the East side of the road known as the Poor Farm Road is inadequate to carry off the drainage waters; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, are desirous of deepening, widening and improving said ditch, said ditch starting at the Northwest corner of the real estate owned by H. W. Sherman and M. V. Sherman and running in a southerly direction to the culvert just short of the railroad tracks;

NOW, THEREFORE, H. W. Sherman and M. V. Sherman, the owners of the above-described property, do hereby give to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, an easement to go upon their land for the purpose of deepening, widening and improving said drainage ditch and do hereby give said Board such authority to pile dirt upon their land to improve said ditch without any compensation to them whatsoever.
