

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD O

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WHEREAS, the County of Douglas County has purchased certain lands East of City of Lawrence, Kansas, to be used in connection with 4-H Club affairs, said real property to be known as 4-H Fairgrounds, Douglas County, Kansas.

AND WHEREAS, the County Engineer of Douglas County, Kansas, and said County commissioners advise that it is expedient and to the best advantage to the public that the township road running East from 19th Street and Learnard Avenue in Wakarusa Township to said Fairgrounds be taken over by said Douglas County, Kansas, and be designated as a County Primary Road and that said road be added to the roads in Douglas County, Kansas, now designated as County Primary Roads; and said county Engineer and said County Commissioners further advise that after studying the matter that the cause of added traffic and other reasons substantiated by said county engineer that the following described road be made and designated a county primary road, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the West Right-of-way of Road Number 127 and the center line of 19th Street in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, (said point of beginning being the West line of quarter section line (approximately 3062 feet), to the quarter corner on the East line of Section 6 - Township 13 South - Range 20 East, (being part of Road Number 112); thence East on the quarter Section line in Section 5 - Township 13 South - Range 20 East, 1/2 mile, to the center quarter corner of said Section 5, thence South on quarter section line approximately 1/2 mile to the North Right-of-Way of Kansas Highway Number 10, (being part of Road Number 57 - Road Number 205, and Road Number 669, in Douglas County, Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in a regular session assembled this 23rd day of June, 1952, that the road as above described be and the same is hereby made and designated as a County Primary Road in Douglas County, Kansas, all as provided by law and as specifically designated by Section 68-506 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949. That a copy of this resolution be sent to Wakarusa Township and to the State Highway Commission of the State of Kansas, and that a copy of this resolution be filed with the County Engineer.
