August 9, 1952.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular adjourned session, with two members present, Mr. Ogden and Mr. Ousdahl.

A delegation of residents west of Lawrence presented to the Board, a petition asking that a road, designated as beginning at the end of 4th Street, north $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles, to the northeast corner of the northeast quarter, Section 23, Township 12, Range 19, extending west $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles to the Lake View road, be blacktopped. The Committee was informed by the Board that no action could be taken at this time because of previous commitments.

Additional bills for equipment and supplies were approved and allowed by the Board as per the Allowance Record.

On motion by Mr. Ousdahl, seconded by Mr. Ogden, the Board increased the per diem board allowance for prisoners from \$1.15 to \$1.25, effective August 1, 1952.
