Vacate part of Road No. 198, beginning 30 feet West of the Quarter (1/4) corner on the South line of Section 21, Twp. 12 South, Range 20 East, thence West on Section line between Sections 21 and 28, Twp. 12 South, Range 20 East, to the South boundary of the Union Pacific Railroad Right of Way.

Locate, beginning at a point 30 feet North of the Quarter (1/4) corner on the South line of Section 21, Twp. 12 South, Range 20 East, thence North on Quarter (1/4) section line to the South boundary of the Union Pacific Railroad Right of Way. Said Road to be 60 feet wide.

Above vacation and location asked for by the Board of Grant Township (John Vogel - Trustee) and the Union Pacific Railroad Co., as of December 15, 1952.

The above vacation and relocation on a temporary abandonment basis was adopted by a resolution by Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, (see County Commissioners Minutes of November 25, 1942)
