The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with Charles Banning and Elmer Ousdahl present.

The Board discussed welfare matters with the Director Mrs. Watson.

Commissioners' Order No. 671 was passed, also #673 with Resolution as typed below.*

Mr. Salsbury, of Salsbury's Floor Covering Company, was authorized to lay tile in the County Attorney's inner office in the amount of \$69.40.

Mrs. Eudaly, County Treasurer, was given permission to install light fixtures in the Treasurer's office. Material and labor is not to exceed \$243.00 and Norris Brothers is to do the work.

Motion was made by Mr. Ousdahl to recind the order to view fence on January 5, 1953, on petition of Rudolph Dietz, said viewing to be held on January 10, 1953. Seconded by Mr. Banning. Motion carried.

*RESOLUTION

WHEREAS Chapter 68, Section 141 G, of the Laws of Kansas, 1947, provides that the "governing body of any municipality by resolution is authorized and empowered to transfer, annually, from the road, bridge, or street fund of such municipality not to exceed twenty-five percent of the amount of money credited to any such fund, and subject to legal expenditure in such year, to a special road, bridge or street building machinery and equipment and bridge building fund,

WHEREAS, Douglas County has a cash balance of \$63,271.96 and an unexpended budget balance of \$66,888.56 in its road fund as of the end of the fiscal year 1952; and,

WHEREAS, Douglas County operated under a budget appropriation of \$250,000.00 in its Road Fund for the year 1952, 25% of which total \$62,500.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County does hereby authorize its treasurer to transfer \$10,800.00 from its Road Fund to the Special Road, Bridge or Street Building machinery, equipment and bridge building Fund, which sum does not exceed 25% of the amount of money which could have been spent as limited by law for the year 1952.
