## RESOLUTION.

## A RESOLUTION CREATING A PLANNING COMMISSION TO ADOPT ZONING REGULATIONS IN DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, on the 17th day of June, 1953, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, all members being present, in a regular session of said Board, unanimously finds that said Douglas County is not operating under a county zoning law and that the City of Lawrence in said county is a first class city, and that said city has established a City Planning Commission and has adopted zoning ordinances as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, said Board of County Commissioners finds that it is deemed necessary and expedient, for the purpose of promoting health, safety, morals, comfort, general welfare and conserving and protecting property and building values in said County, that a Planning Commission be established, all as provided by law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, on this 17th day of June, 1953, that a planning Commission be and the same is created and established in said County to provide for the preparation, adoption, amendment, extension, enforcement and variation of zoning regulations within the unincorporated territory lying within three miles of the City Limits of Lawrence, Kansas, a first class city, and said Board of County Commissioners does hereby appoint as members of said Planning Commission the following named persons, who are all residents of the unincorporated portion of Douglas County, Kansas, to be affected by the zoning regulations as herein provided, each to serve the following terms, to-wit:

Fred Kloepper	1 year
Roland Roney	2 years
H. D. Craig	2 years
Harold Chamney	3 years
Elmer Husted	3 years

and the County Engineer of said County shall be an ex-officio member of said Planning Commission, as provided by law.

This Resolution shall become effective and be in force upon and after its publication in the official Douglas County, Kansas newspaper.
