The Joint Boards of Leavenworth and Douglas Counties met in Special session in the Douglas County Board of Commissioners' room in Lawrence. Leavenworth County was represented by Lon Rush, Chairman, Ralph B. Eshelman and Floyd Warden, members, and H. V. Parr, County Engineer. Charles E. Banning, Chairman, Elmer W. Ousdahl and Ray C. Ogden, members of the Board, J. I. Rice, County Engineer and Robert Oyler, Assistant County Attorney, represented Douglas County.

The meeting was for the purpose of settling the affairs in connection with the Eudora Bridge protection works under contract No. DA-23-028 Eng. 1783.

A check in the amount of \$46,000 made payable to the joint boards of Leavenworth and Douglas Counties, was received and endorsed by the Chairmen of both Boards to the credit of Douglas County. Upon receipt of the amount of \$22,280.87 from Leavenworth County, which is their proportionate share of the remaining amount, in favor of Douglas, Douglas County agrees to make final settlement with the contractor in the amount of \$84,834.64.
