R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas Have met at a regular session on this 26th day of September, 1953, the following commissioners being present: Chairman Charles E. Banning, Commissioner Elmer W. Ousdahl and Commissioner Ray C. Ogden.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners now finds and declares that a drought emergency exists in Douglas County, Kansas, and finds that authority vested in them under Section 19-3001 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, thereby authorizing and empowering said board of County Commissioners to appropriate and expend from the general fund of Douglas County, Kansas the sum of one Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for the purpose of purchasing pumping equipment for the operation of drought relief wells or for pumping from streams, and other machinery, equipment and materials, including fuel, which shall be come necessary for the construction or maintenance of drought relief water supply projects.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a drought emergency exists within said Douglas County, Kansas, and said commission hereby appropriates the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) to be expended from the general fund of said county for the purpose of purchasing pumping equipment for operation of drought relief wells or for pumping from streams, and other machinery, equipment and materials, including fuel, deemed necessary for construction or maintenance of drought relief water supply projects.
