No one appearing to protest the annexation of property by the City of Lawrence as set forth in the petition and further described as beginning at the NW corner of Section 1 Township 13 and Range 19, etc., the same is hereby granted on motion by Mr. Ogden and seconded by Mr. Banning:

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, ON PETITION TO ENLARGE THE
BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, did on the 7th day of December, 1953, file with the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, its petition to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, for authority and approval to enlarge the limits of the City of Lawrence Kansas by including the following described tract adjacent to said City within the limits of said City, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Section No. One (1), Township No. Thirteen (13) South, Range No. Nine-teen (19) East; thence east along the North Line of said Section One Thousand One Hundred and Seventy-six (1,176.0) feet; thence in a Southwesterly direction on a curve of One Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-two (1,592.0) feet radius, a distance of three Hundred Thirty-nine (339.0) feet, more or less, the same being the West line of Grandview Clarkson Place Sub-division; thence South Sixty-eight (68) Degrees, Forty-six (46) Minutes, East One Hundred Eighty-seven (187.0) feet; thence East Four Hundred Four (404.0) feet; thence North Three Hundred Sixty-nine and Six-tenths (369.6) feet to the North line of said Section No. One (1); thence East along the North Line of said Section No. One (1), One thousand Twenty-seven and Eighty-nine One Hundredths (1,027.89) feet, to the Northeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of said Section No. One (1); thence South to the Southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of said Section No. One (1); thence West to the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of said Section No. One (1); thence North to the Point of beginning; containing One Hundred Fifty-five and five-tenths (155.5) acres, more or less.

and to make a finding as to the advisability of adding said territory to said City, all as provided by Section 12-501 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, and

WHEREAS, the said matter was duly set for hearing on the 28th day of December, 1953, at 9:00 o'clock A.M., in the Commissioner's room of the Courthouse of Douglas County, Kansas, in the City of Lawrence, Kansas, and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing was duly published for three consecutive weeks as provided by law in the Lawrence Daily Journal World, the same being a newspaper of general circulation in said City, and

WHEREAS, on the aforesaid date and time and at the aforementioned place, the said Board of County Commissioners did proceed to hear testimony as to the advisability of making the addition requested in the above mentioned petition, as provided in Section 12-502 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, and
