The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with two members present, Mr. Banning and Mr. Ogden.

Commissioners' Order #691, cancelling certain personal taxes, was made.

The following resolution was passed by the Board authorizing the transfer of Funds from the Road Fund to a special Road, Bridge, or Street Building Machinery and Equipment Fund:

## RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, Chapter 68, Section 141 G. of the Laws of Kansas, 1947 provides that the "governing body of any municipality by resolution is authorized and empowered to transfer, annually, from the road, bridge, or street fund of such municipality not to exceed twenty-five percent of the amount of money credited to any such fund, and subject to legal expenditure in such year, to a special road, bridge or street building machinery and ~~bridge building~~ fund, and

WHEREAS, Douglas County has a cash balance of \$41,343.30 and an unexpended budget balance of \$36,814.00 in its road-~~bridge~~ fund as of the end of the fiscal year 1953; and,

WHEREAS, Douglas County operated under a budget appropriation of \$250,000.00 in its Road, ~~fund~~ <sup>bridge</sup> fund for the year 1953 25% of which total \$62,500.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County does hereby authorize its treasurer to transfer \$33,000.00 from its Road ~~fund~~ <sup>bridge</sup> fund to the Special Road, ~~bridge or street building machinery~~ <sup>bridge</sup> fund, which sum does not exceed 25% of the amount of money which could have been spent as limited by law for the year 1953.
