The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

The Board discussed road matters with Mr. Charles Houk of Stull, and Road and Bridge matters with J. I. Rice, County Engineer. Mr. Charles Houk presented a petition for a dust-free road thru Stull.

The Board contracted with Perry Jones for the purchase of 10,000 tons of rock during 1954 for \$1.15 per ton, by resolution:

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas, sitting in regular session, this 13th day of February 1954, that we purchase from Perry Jones, 10,000 tons of crushed rock at \$1.15 per ton, subject to the following conditions:

Said rock to be crusher run with maximum size of 100% will pass thru 1 1/2" screen; be reasonably free from dirt and satisfactory to the County Engineer. Said rock to be taken from the stock piles or conveyor belt at crushing plant when crusher is operating. Rock is to be produced by Perry Jones and supplied from various quarries located in Douglas County. All rock to be weighed, when delivered to the County, on approved scales or checked by measurement satisfactory to County Engineer.

Payment for the 10,000 tons of rock to be made as soon as it has been placed in the stock piles.
