RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a petition for the vacation of streets, alleys and land in the City of Eudora, Douglas County, Kansas, has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, as provided by Section 12-504 of the General Statutes of Kansas for 1949, signed by Raymond C.
