Banning and Chairman Elmer W. Ousdahl being present, said Board of County Commissioners consider the proposing of a judicial foreclosure and sale of real estate by said County, and

WHEREAS, the counties of the State of Kansas are directed by pertinent sections of Chapter 79 of the General Statutes of the State of Kansas, 1949, as amended, to file a foreclosure action and to enforce liens for unredeemed real estate bid in by said County and to sell all lots, tracts and pieces of land which have been carried on the tax rolls for a prescribed number of years, and which have not been redeemed according to law, all as provided in Chapter 79 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, as amended, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient lots, tracts and pieces of land on the tax rolls of Douglas County, Kansas, which have been carried on the tax rolls of said County and which have been bid in in the name of said County and advertised for sale as delinquent taxes, and which have not been redeemed, all as provided by law, to justify a judicial foreclosure and that all of said lots, tracts and pieces of land are now subject to judicial foreclosing as above mentioned, and

WHEREAS, said Board of County Commissioners finds that there is an aggregate assessed valuation of such real estate subject to sale in an amount of \$10,000.00 or more, thereby making it mandatory that said Board order a judicial foreclosure, sell the lots, tracts and pieces of land and thereby place the same back on the tax rolls on a paying basis.
