## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Ransas, has met at a regular session on this 10th day of January, 1955, the following Commissioners being present: Chairman Elmer W. Ousdahl, Commissioner Charles E. Banning, and Commissioner Ray C. Ogden.

WHEREAR, the Board of Covery Commissioners, after having first received an application from the Cooperative Farm Chemicals Association for necessary authority to cross township read No. 6A at points within 66.5 feet East of the Southwest corner of the East Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section Thirty-three, Township Twelve South, Range Twenty East in order to anter said Cooperative Farm Chemical Association's property with pipe lines and power lines on the South side of said read in Section Four. That the Cooperative Farm Chemicale Association has represented to this Board that it will bury its pipe lines at least two and one-half feet under the surface of the existing readway and said power lines will be at a minimum height of thirty feet and will not impair or emianger the use of said highway by the public. Said Cooperative Farm Chemical's Association further has represented to taid Board that if the Township or the County shall incur any costs in repairing said readway by reason of excavations said Association will pay for the same.

The Board finds that the Gooperative Farm Chemicals Association has a place of business located at Lawrence, Kansas, and is the awner of an interest in real property consisting of water rights and eccements located in land on the North side of Township Read 6A in Douglas County, Kansas, described as follows:

> the East Half of the South west Fractional Quarter of Section Thirty-three. Towaship Twolve South. Range Twenty East, also the ... et of the Northwest Quarter of Section Thirty-incree. South of the Rancas River and East of S baske's Drainage Ditch.

Further, that said Association is the owner of the les title of real property located in Section Four, Township Twelve South, Range Twenty East inimediately South of the above described yeal estate and on the South side of said Township Road No. 6A:
