

The Board further finds that the Cooperative Farm Chemicals Association's application to install water lines under Township Road No. 6A and power lines over said road should be granted and that this Board should enter into a proper conveyance with the Township Board of Highway Commissioners to make the necessary grant to the Cooperative Farm Chemicals Association.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the application of the Cooperative Farm Chemicals Association for an appropriate grant to install water lines under and power lines over Township Road 6A in Douglas County, Kansas, at a point 66.5 feet East of the Southwest corner of the East Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section Thirty-three, Township Twelve South, Range Twenty East in order to enter its property with said pipe lines and power lines on the South side of said road in Section Four be granted with the understanding that said pipe lines will be buried at least two and one-half feet under the surface of the existing roadway and said power lines will be at a minimum height of thirty feet and will not impair or endanger the use of said highway by the public; and the further understanding that the Cooperative Farm Chemicals Association will restore said roadway to as good a condition as now exists and if said Township or the County shall incur any costs in repairing said roadway by reason of said excavations the Cooperative Farm Chemicals Association will pay the same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an appropriate easement be entered into between the Cooperative Farm Chemicals Association, this Board and the Township Board of Highway Commissioners giving legal credence and effect to the foregoing Resolution.
