RESOLUTION GRANTING GREAT LAKES PIPE LINE COMPANY PERMISSION  
 TO CONSTRUCT PIPE LINE:

This matter coming on for hearing this 31st day of January, 1955, upon the application of the Great Lakes Pipe Line Company for authority to lay its ten inch pipe line along a certain route as shown by map attached hereto, and it appearing that said authority should be granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that permission is hereby granted the Great Lakes Pipe Line Company, a corporation, to lay, construct, build and maintain a pipe line over, along and across the public roads and highways of Douglas County, Kansas, at the points and places on such roads and highways shown on the map attached hereto designating the route of said pipe line in said county, the construction of said line over, along and across such highway to be subject to the inspection and supervision of the County Engineer of said county.
