NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that Resolution No. 2045 of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, be adopted and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas:

SECTION I. That it is expedient and necessary, and in the public interest, to grade, curb, and pave Nineteenth Street in the City of Lawrence, Kansas, and the connecting street which lies West of the corporate limits of said city and extends West to Highway 59, being a distance of less than five-eighths of a mile in the country outside the corporate limits and that said proposed improvement is declared a public utility, and that the cost thereof be paid as provided in Sections 12-647 to 12-655B inclusive, of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949.

SECTION II. That the part or portion of the total cost of making said improvement as provided by law, to be paid for by said county in the manner provided by law, which bond shall be paid in ten annual assessments to be levied upon lots, lands, or parcels of land, situated within said benefit district and upon property in the County at large upon the following basis: Thirty percent of the total cost of said improvement to be paid for by the County at large, and twenty percent thereof shall be paid and assessed against land in that part of the benefit district lying outside and without the corporate limits of said city, as provided for in Section 12-652 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949.

SECTION III. That under the authority of Section 12-649 the benefit district lying outside and without the corporate limits of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, shall comprise the area hereafter described and is hereby established, laid out and described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest Corner of the East Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 1, Township 13, Range 19, thence East 100 feet, thence South 250 feet, thence West 100 feet, thence North 250 feet to the point of beginning.

Beginning 660 feet North of the Southwest corner of the East Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 1, Township 13, Range 19, thence North 660 feet, thence East 264 feet, thence South 660 feet, thence West 264 feet to point of beginning, less .574 acres by Deed 169, Page 111, and Less .941 acres by Deed 181, Page 200.

and, the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section One, Township 13, Range 19.

SECTION IV. That final action on the proposed improvement will be taken by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, on the 6th day of April, 1955, at 10:30 o'clock a.m. in the Douglas County Courthouse, Lawrence, Kansas, when complaints will be heard and protests may be filed against the proposed improvement.

SECTION V. that notice shall be given to all interested persons of the date fixed for the hearing of all complaints and protests, namely, the 6th day of April, 1955, at 10:30 a.m. against the proposed improvement and a copy of this Resolution shall be published in the official county paper in two consecutive weekly issues thereof. The first publication of said notice shall be published not less than twenty days prior to the date fixed for the hearing of said complaints and protests
