

## COMMISSIONER'S RECORD O

## A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARY LINES OF PART OF ROAD NUMBER 158A UNDER GENERAL STATUTES 1949 68-108

WHEREAS, The true course of Road Number 158A running north and south in the Southwest Quarter (SW<sup>1</sup>) of Section Thirty Three (33) Township Twelve (12), Range Twenty (20) East, Douglas County, Kansas, has been uncertain and unknown for many years, and,

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has constituted itself a board of review, and has caused the County Surveyor to make a survey thereof, and together they have viewed the same, and have caused the boundary lines of said road to be correctly marked and platted:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular meeting assembled this 23rd day of May, 1955:

1. That part of road Number 158A running north and south in the Southwest Quarter of Section 33, Township 12, Range 20 East shall be bounded and located as follows:

The base line for said part of road Number 158A shall be a line running from the 1/8 corner on the south line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 33, Township 12, South, Range 20 East, thence due north on the 1/8 line 2160 feet. The entire west boundary of said road shall run exactly parallel with said base line 60 feet west thereof and the east boundary of said roadway shall run exactly parallel with said base line 16.5 feet east thereof; and said part of said roadway having an overall width at said locations of 76.5 feet.

2. The foregoing description and location shall be in accordance with a survey and a plat thereof approved and certified January 24, 1955, by L. D. Rice, county Surveyor of Douglas County, Kansas.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall constitute the certification of this Board as provided by G.S. 1949, 68-108, and that the survey and plat of the County Surveyor, together with this certificate, shall be recorded as in other cases, and thenceforth said road surveyed as aforesaid shall be considered a public highway.
