The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

A beer license was granted to Harry A. Litvin, Flamingo Club, in Grant Township. (Resolution on file in the office of the County Clerk.

Road and bridge matters were discussed with J. I. Rice, County Engineer.

Mrs. Mildred Watson was present to discuss welfare matters.

The Board passed a resolution establishing joint mental health clinic with the City, as per House Bill #125:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have met at a regular session on this 4th day of June, 1955, the following commissioners being present: Chairman Charles E. Banning, Commissioner Elmer W. Ousdahl and Commissioner D. M. Harris.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners find that Douglas County, Kansas has a population of more than 28,000 and less than 50,000 wherein there has been established a joint board of health composed of the County of Douglas and the City of Lawrence, a City of first-class and,

WHEREAS, House Bill No. 125 passed by the 1955 session of the Kansas Legislature, authorizes the establishment of mental health clinics in certain counties and a tax levy therefore,

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary, expedient and in the public interest to establish a mental health clinic for the diagnosis and treatment of mental illness to be operated by and be subject to the jurisdiction of the joint board of health of the County of Douglas, and the City of Lawrence,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a mental health clinic be and it is hereby established as provided by House Bill No. 125, passed by the 1955 session of the Kansas Legislature, and that the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, annually make a levy upon all taxable tangible property in such county not in excess of one-fourth ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) mill on each dollar of assessed valuation of such property, and the proceeds thereof shall be placed in the hands of the Treasurer of said joint board of health, to be administered as provided by Section 65-206 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, or any amendment thereto; all of such proceeds to be subject to protest as provided by House Bill No. 125 as passed by the 1955 session of the Kansas Legislature.
