

craft is in a safe condition. Upon receipt of license, licensee must display the license number issued him upon said boat.

4. The boat license fee is \$1.00 for the season and shall expire at midnight on June 30th of each calendar year, unless sooner suspended or revoked. A daily permit may be issued upon payment of a fee of 25 cents for a specified day. Any license may be suspended or revoked by the Park Superintendent for any violation of these rules, or for carelessly or recklessly operating any boat hauling passengers for a fee, or for any other misconduct or violation of rules. Such revocation may be appealed to the Board of County Commissioners within three (3) days after the suspension or revocation by the Park Superintendent. Licenses thus revoked can only be restored or a new one obtained by making application to the Board of County Commissioners.

5. It shall be unlawful to operate any boat on any part of the Lake where boating is forbidden as indicated by markers, buoys, or other signs, and all persons maintaining, operating or riding in boats on the lake shall obey all directions, requests, orders and demands of the persons in charge of the lake and grounds.

6. No boat shall be licensed except one that is seaworthy, well constructed, balanced, manageable, not likely to capsize, leak, or damage other boats upon coming in contact therewith, and having sufficient buoyancy when loaded to capacity.

7. All boats placed on Lake must be docked at the boat docks provided, and the placing of boats on the lake at any other point is prohibited. All boats must be licensed and launched at boat docks.

REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO MOTORS

1. No person shall operate any boat motor on the waters of Lake without complying with the provisions hereinafter made.

2. Any person desiring to operate a motor must first secure a license or permit from the superintendent of the lake. Motors can only be used on boats that comply with the rules and regulations governing the use of boats on the lake.

3. No person will be permitted to operate a motor until a motor fee of \$3.00 shall be paid for a season license to expire on June 30th of each year, or 25c paid for a daily permit.

4. Motors shall be limited in size not to exceed a developed 7½ O.N.O.A. certified brake horsepower, and at no time exceed a speed on the lake of more than 8 miles an hour. Mufflers must be used at all times.

5. No motor boat shall operate within 50 feet of shoreline nor approach within 50 feet of another craft when passing. Operators of motor boats must be extremely careful and prudent at all times so as not to endanger life and shall not maneuver his boat so as to unnecessarily discomfort others or interfere with any person who may be fishing from the shore.

6. Motor boats in use at night on the lake must carry a light posted restricted areas. Boats when meeting shall turn to the right, and when overtaking another boat shall turn to the left, will yield the right-of-way to the boat on the right. Sailboats shall have the right-of-way at all times.

7. Any owner of a motor who allows another person to use the

boat who shall maneuver it to the discomfort and danger of others may have his license cancelled.

8. Special rules will be adopted to govern special events.

9. Failure to comply with these regulations may result in the cancellation of both the boat and motor licenses if in the opinion of the superintendent such action will be for the best interests of the lake.

PENALTIES

1. Any violations of the above rules shall be deemed a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$200.00 or 30 days in jail, or both such fine and imprisonment, and upon violation of said rules any licenses pertaining to said lake may be suspended, forfeited or cancelled by the Board of County Commissioners.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION AND SUBSEQUENT REGULATIONS

This resolution adopting rules and regulations to govern Lane Star Lake and Lane Star Park shall take effect and become effective upon publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Douglas County, Kansas. Said rules may be repealed, changed, amended or altered, or new rules made, by one publication in such newspaper.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

All laws of the State of Kansas pertaining to fishing in State Lakes are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference herein the same as though set out at length herein, in so far as they are not inconsistent with the provisions herein set out.

Lane Star Lake Park is open and free to the public. Visitors are welcome to use it for the various activities permitted.

1. The destruction of any sign, kiosk, post, or property of any kind is unlawful. This includes the peeling of bark, carving and chopping trees, cutting branches, driving nails, digging ground from roots, and the removal of trees, shrubs and plants, picking wild flowers, and other injuries.

2. To carry or have firearms in the park is unlawful.

3. Throwing of tin cans, bottles, paper, junk or refuse of any kind on the ground or in the lake; or the misuse or abuse of seats, tables, park buildings, and other park equipment is prohibited.

4. Washing or throwing of waste of any kind around water faucets or fountains or the use of woods as toilets, or the use of toilets as bath houses is prohibited.

5. Building or starting fires in the open or in any place except where the proper provisions have been made is prohibited.

6. Dogs in the park must be tied with a chain or controlled by a leash. They are not allowed to run loose about the park.

7. Speed limit on park roads for vehicles is 25 miles per hour except where otherwise posted.

8. Horseback riding or driving automobiles or other vehicles on picnic grounds, children's playgrounds, and areas posted against such traffic or use is prohibited.

9. Camping in the park is prohibited except in the areas set aside for organized youth groups to be used only by special permission secured from the Lane Star Lake Park Superintendent. Groups using camp must comply with park regulations and in addition must conform with the required minimum standards for use of the camp.

10. Disorderly conduct in the way of drunkenness, vile language, fighting and personal exposure by change of clothing in automobiles, woods, park or any other place where person is not properly sheltered is prohibited.

11. Bathing, swimming or wading is prohibited with the exception that wading with boats during open fishing season will be permitted.

12. Lane Star is a game sanctuary. Hunting, shooting, killing, trapping, injuring, pursuing, or molesting in any way any bird or animal on or within the park is prohibited.

13. Fishing in Lane Star Lake is prohibited except under such rules and regulations as hereinafter set out by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas.

14. The use of water craft is prohibited except under such rules and
