The Board approved Commissioners' Orders #734 and #735.

The following Order was passed by the Board in regard to construction of Eudora Bridge and condemnation of right-of-way:

IN RE: The condemnation and Appropriation of certain land taken for the use of the County for Road Purposes namely, the widening of the County Road North of the Wakarusa Bridge at Eudora, Kansas.

## ORDER CONDEMNING LAND

In regard to the condemnation and appropriation of certain land in Douglas County, Kansas, for the purpose of acquiring and procuring certain land for road purposes, namely, the widening of the County Road from the North end of the Wakarusa Bridge at Eudora, Kansas, to a point 538 feet North, the following Order is made, to wit:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that it is necessary to appropriate certain private property in Douglas County, Kansas, for public use, to wit:

Begin at the North bank of the Wakarusa Creek, in the City of Eudora, where it cuts the East Line of "F" Street, thence North 538 feet, thence East 25 feet, thence South 538 feet, thence West 25 feet to point of beginning, containing .308 acres, all in Douglas County, Kansas.

It is further ordered that the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, will meet at 10: A.M., December 16th, 1955, at the location of the above described property at which time they will view and appraise said property.

It is further ordered that the County Engineer of Douglas County, Kansas, will meet with the Board of County Commissioners at the above time and place.
