- (2). Slide out every fifth stone and fill under with concrete, continue to fill with concrete as far as it will run down grade.
- (3) Remove stone next to top stone of steps and fill with cement mortar and brick bats.
- (4) All riser stone chipped from age to be patched with white cement.

All material and labor to be furnished by me except concrete and rock. All work to be done in workmanlike manner for the sum of \$405.00.

The Board approved claims for damages to widening secondary road #290 North of Baldwin:

"WE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, Acting Under the Laws of 1923, Chapter 68 Article 114, which reads as follows, "Proceedings for changes in roads". When it is found necessary to layout, relocate, alter, widen or vacate a road or highway for the purpose of eliminating sharp turns or other dangerous places, or for the proper construction of a highway, or for the extension of a bridge or culvert, the Board of County Commissioners shall by order of said Board layout, relocate, alter, or widen a public road and may vacate an existing road. All land required for the laying out, widening or altering of a road shall be acquired by the Board of County Commissioners by purchase or by donation."

We, do hereby order the Number 290 County road, between Sections 33/34, Twp. 14 South, Range 20 East, widened to 60 feet in width and acting as Viewers do hereby order that the route as surveyed under our direction by L. D. Rice, County Surveyor, assisted by t. S. McGee and A. M. Ousdahl and Robert Dark chainmen, is for the public good and convenience.

Be it hereby ordered by the Board of County Commissioners that these proceedings and the report of survey be recorded.
