The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

Road and bridge matters were discussed with J. I. Rice, County Engineer.

Motion was made by Mr. Banning and seconded by Mr. Harris that special events be held at Lone Star Lake permitting skiing in restricted areas on the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays in the month of August from noon until dusk, subject to rules and regulations adopted by the County Commissioners under rule 8 on regulation pertaining to motors:

## Rules Governing Water Skiing on Lone Star Lake.

1. Lone Star Lake will be open in a restricted area designated by buoys from noon on Wednesday till dusk for water skiing only. (2nd and 4th Wednesday in August.)
2. Skiing is at your own risk. The county will assume no liability for any accidents.
3. No swimming is allowed.
4. All boats must be equipped with a life preserver for each occupant and for the skier.
5. A counterclockwise traffic pattern will be maintained at all times, always keeping buoys on the right. A boat may circle counterclockwise to pick up a fallen skier.
6. All motors must be equipped with mufflers.
7. All boats and motors must be registered with the lake superintendent. Each boat operator and skier must read the rules and regulations before he or she is allowed on the lake.
8. All boats must be operated at idle speed within fifty feet of launching or docking areas.
9. An interval of at least seventy-five feet must be maintained between any boats towing skiers.
10. Violation of any of the above regulations will be considered cause for removal from lake.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Wednesday, August 8th 1956.
