

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD O

C O N T R A C T

This contract made and entered into this 12th day of September, 1956 by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, hereinafter called party of the first part; and Perry Jones, of Carbondale, Kansas, hereinafter called party of the second part:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, by Resolution duly adopted, the first party considers it is necessary to purchase 45,000 tons of road material, as herein described, for the maintenance and repair of county roads and the first party resolved to purchase said materials as hereinafter recited;

NOW, THEREFORE, as authorized by the laws of Kansas, and in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein recited, it is by said parties agreed:

1. The second party will furnish and sell to the first party, and the first party will purchase from the second party, road repair materials as follows:
 - (a) 45,000 tons of crushed road rock material of one and $\frac{1}{2}$ inches or less diameter (which will pass through a rock screen of 1" square mesh);

for the agreed purchase price of \$1.15 per ton, which purchase price shall be paid to the second party at Lawrence, Kansas, upon estimated tonnage, as and when the material is crushed and stockpiled as herein recited.
2. Said material will be crushed at various quarries in Douglas county operated by second party and stockpiled on the premises of said quarrying and crushing sites. The amounts to be processed and stockpiled at the respective sites shall be designated by memo to be delivered by said County Engineer to second party prior to October 1st, 1956.
3. The first party shall weigh each load of rock at the time it removes the same and the second party guarantees the full measurement of the estimated tonnage paid for by the first party in the respective stockpiles.
4. This contract shall be binding upon the heirs, devisees, legatees, successors and assigns of the parties.
