

RESOLUTION

*Richard Anderson Road Petition*

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in a regular meeting of said Commissioners on November 10, 1956, all of said County Commissioners being present; and

WHEREAS, on said date there comes before said Board of County Commissioners the matter of the consideration of a road petition, which was duly filed on the 10 day of Nov, 1956, said petition being signed by Paul Richard Anderson as the principal petitioner and by at least twelve householders of Douglas County, Kansas, residing in the vicinity where said roads are to be laid out, and praying for the location of said roads as more specifically described in said road petition; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 68-104 of the G. S. of 1949 as amended, Paul Richard Anderson and Fae Ann Anderson, his wife, the owners of the land proposed to be taken in the location of said roads as described in said petition, have agreed, in writing, to the proposed location of said roads and have waived any right to any damage resulting from the location of said roads as set out in said petition; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, are satisfied that the location of said roads as set out in said petition is practicable and can be made without unreasonable expense; and

WHEREAS, the Wakarusa Township Board of Trustees are favorable that the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, open and locate said roads as set out in said petition; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer of Douglas County, Kansas, has examined the notes and descriptions of said roads as set forth in said petition and has found that said descriptions of said roads are true and correct and that the land proposed to be taken for said roads belongs to and is the property of Paul Richard Anderson and Fae Ann Anderson, his wife, and has so reported his findings to The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the following described roads, to-wit:
