

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD P

290, shall comply with and conform to the said map, profile, plans, and specifications prepared therefor, by the County Engineer of Douglas County, Kansas.

3. It is hereby determined by said Board that the approximate amount and location of land to be taken for said purpose is all situated in Douglas County, Kansas, and described as follows:

Beginning at the quarter corner on the west line of Section 27, Township 14 South, Range 19 East; thence East 45 feet; thence in a northeasterly direction to a point 70 feet East and 130 feet north of beginning; thence in a northeasterly direction to a point 212 feet East and 390 feet north of beginning; thence North-easterly to a point 310 feet East and 660 feet North of beginning; thence West to the west line of Section 27, Twp. 14, Range 20; thence South 660 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2.63 Acres, more or less.

Beginning 660 feet North and 185 feet East of $\frac{1}{4}$ corner on the West line of Section 27, Township 14 South, Range 20 East; thence in a Northeasterly direction to a point 50 feet East and 330 feet North of beginning; thence 12 feet East; thence on a curve having a radius of 825.98 feet for a distance of 380 feet; thence West 220 feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.83 Acres more or less; also, beginning at the North $\frac{1}{8}$ corner on the West line of Section 27, Township 14 South, Range 20 East, and east to a point 42 feet West of the center line of County Road No. 290; thence South 343 feet parallel to said center line; thence East 12 feet; thence North parallel to said centerline 343 feet; thence West 12 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.09 Acres more or less.

Beginning at the North $\frac{1}{8}$ corner on the West line of Section 27, Township 14 South, Range 20 East, and east to a point 42 feet west of the centerline of County Road No. 290; thence in a northerly direction 680 feet parallel to centerline of said road; thence East 12 feet; thence in a southerly direction parallel to the centerline of said road; thence West 12 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.18 Acres, more or less; also, beginning 30 feet East and 20 feet South of the Northwest corner of Section 27, Township 14 South, Range 20 East; thence 12 feet East; thence in a southerly direction parallel to the centerline of County Road No. 290 to the eighth line; thence West 12 feet thence in a northerly direction parallel to said centerline to the point of beginning, containing 0.36 Acres, more or less.

Beginning 30 feet west of the northeast corner of Section 28, Township 14 South, Range 20 East; thence South 660 feet parallel to centerline of County Road No. 290; thence West 12 feet; thence north 660 feet parallel to said centerline; thence East 12 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.18 acres, more or less.

Beginning 30 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 21, Township 14 South, Range 20 East; thence North parallel to centerline of County Road No. 290, 785 feet to Railroad R/W; thence West 12 feet along Railroad R/W; thence South 785 feet parallel to said centerline; thence East 12 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.21 acres, more or less.

4. That the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, will meet at 9:00 o'clock A.M., on the 16th day of August, 1957, at the locations of the above described property, at which time they will view and appraise said property.

5. That at said viewing, the said Board of County Commissioners shall assess damages by reason of the taking thereof, and if said work shall not be completed on said day, they will adjourn from day to day without further notice, until their labors are fully completed.

6. That the County Engineer is hereby directed to meet with the said Board of County Commissioners at said time and place for such view.

7. That notice of the time and place of such viewing shall be given as provided by law, and all persons claiming or to claim damages by reason of the proceedings and actions of the Board of County Commissioners in reference to said view and the changes to be made in the said County road shall file their applications therefor in writing, with the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, on or before the 1st day of the next regular session of the Board of County Commissioners, which meets on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays of each week at 9:00 A.M., following the filing of the report of the findings upon such view, and at such regular session of the Board, the Board will finally determine upon the amount to be paid as damages to the owners of the above described property.

8. That the County Clerk shall spread this resolution and order at length, upon the Journal.
