of said City, and shall be maintained and improved in accordance with the laws relating to County benefit districts subject to supervision by the City.

(5) The City shall construct, maintain, and operate the necessary sewerage facilities to convey the sanitary sewage from the areas covered by this Contract to the City's sewage treatment works and provide treatment comparable to that provided sewage originating with the City of Lawrence.

(6) The City agrees to provide adequate treatment facilities for the sewage reaching the treatment plant, regardless of origin, providing that the character of such sewage conforms to standards established by the City. The City further agrees to construct, at its expense, additional sewage treatment facilities if such facilities are required to maintain a satisfactory degree of treatment or to comply with the orders of regulatory agencies having jurisdiction over the discharge of wastes to streams.

(7) All contributors of sewage to the system shall be required to pay sewerage service charges to the City at rates and in accordance with terms established from time to time by ordinances of the City of Lawrence. Said charges shall be established by methods similar to those used for determining charges for sewerage service within the City. All users of the facilities shall be billed directly by the City and shall be subject to all laws, ordinances, rules, regulations, and conditions of service governing the operation of the Sewer Department of the City of Lawrence, now in effect or hereafter lawfully adopted.

(8) Sewer service shall be provided only in areas conforming to the subdivision requirements of the City and approved by the City.

(9) The City shall have the right to discharge sewage from any portion of its sewer system lying within the present city limits, or any future extension of the City Limits, or from any area in which extension of the City Limits is proposed by the City, to any sewer constructed to service the area covered by this contract regardless of whether the sewers were constructed by the City, County, or district, subdistricts, private developers, or industrial establishment. The City may make these connections without any obligation to assume any part of the original construction cost, either costs previously paid, or debt outstanding at the time of the connection. The City shall, at its expense, construct necessary relief sewers if the introduction of sewage from City sewers as outlined above overloads the existing sewers, either at the time of the connection or at any future date.
