Now on this 11th day of December, 1957, at a duly constituted and regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, a quorum being present, it is brought to the attention of the Board that a petition asking for the creation of a sewer and taxing district within Wakarusa Township, Douglas County, Kansas, adjoining the City of Lawrence and Northwest of the city limits, for the construction of a sanitary trunk sewer therefore has been filed with said Board.

The County Clerk is instructed to examine and check the petition and determine the sufficiency of the same. After a brief interval, the County Clerk reports that the petition is sufficient; that more than 51% of the owners of acreage in the proposed sewer district have signed said petition.

THEREUPON, after due consideration, on motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, said Board fixes the 27th day of December, 1957, at 10:00 o'clock as the time for public hearing on said petition, said hearing to be held at the office of said Board in the Commissioners' Chambers at the Court House, Lawrence, Kansas.

The Board questioned Charles D. Stough, Attorney, who had handled the preliminary legal work in connection with this project relative to the proceedings thus far, were advised that the petition was in order and that notice should be published advising all interested parties of the date of hearing. After due consideration on motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, said Board designates Charles D. Stough as legal counsel to handle all legal matters in connection with the proposed sanitary sewer benefit district.

The Board further authorized, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the execution of a contract with Black and Veatch for the necessary engineering work in connection with said project.

It was further ordered by the Board that notice of said hearing be published in the official county paper for three consecutive issues. Thereupon, said notice
