The following Resolution annexing land to the Colyer Cemetery District was passed by the Board:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a petition setting forth and requesting the annexation of the hereinafter described land to the Colyer Cemetery District, and signed by not less than fifty-one percent of the qualified electors of said proposed annexed district, which has been determined by an enumeration taken and verified for this purpose by Elmer E. Churchbaugh and Frank A. Deay, qualified electors of said proposed annexed district, has been presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in which lies all of the territory comprising said annexed territory, and

WHEREAS, the said Board of County Commissioners at its next regular meeting held on this 2nd day of June, 1958, did examine said Petition and find that said Petition is regular and in due form with provisions of G.S. 1955 Supp., 17-1335 (1).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular meeting, held this 2nd day of June, 1958, a quorum of said Board being present, that they shall and do hereby enter an order annexing the following described territory to Colyar Cemetery District, and that the same will hereinafter be a part of the Colyar Cemetery District:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section 6, Township 14, Range 20, thence West along the North boundary line to the Northwest corner of said Section 6, thence continuing West along the North boundary lines of Sections 1, 2 and 3 to the Northwest corner of said Section 3, same being the East boundary line of the present and existing Colyar Cemetery District, thence South along East boundary line of said district and on the West lines of Sections, 3, 10, 15, 22, 27 and 34 to the South west corner of said Section 34, thence East along the South line of Sections 34, 35 and 36 to the Southeast corner of said Section 36, all in Township 14, Range 19, thence continuing East along the South line of Section 31, Township 14, Range 20 to the Southeast corner of said Section 31, thence North along the East lines of Sections 31, 30, 19, 18, 7 and 6 to the Northeast corner of said Section 6, same being the point of beginning, all in Douglas County, Kansas.
