

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS,
RELATING TO THE CREATION OF A SANITARY SEWER
TAKING DISTRICT AND OTHER MATTERS INCIDENT
THERETO.

Now on this 27th day of December, 1937, at 10:00 o'clock A.M., the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, met in regular session at his office in the Court House in the City of Lawrence in said county and state with two members present and participating, to-wit:

THEREUPON, after due discussion and consideration the following Resolution was adopted:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners filed by the owners or others having expressly reserved the right to do so of more than 51% of the area of land sought to be included in a proposed sewer and taxing district and asking for the construction of an adequate sanitary sewer therein and the doing of all things necessary or incident thereto, and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that Douglas County, Kansas has a population in excess of 21,000 and less than 140,000 persons, viz.: 33,683 as shown by the records in the office of the County Clerk of said County, and
